Approval of January 14, 2014 Meeting Minutes:

Motion: Bryan Davis made a motion to approve the January 14, 2014 meeting minutes as presented with a second by Brett Houser. Motion carried unanimously.

E-Plan Update

Chairman Byrd reminded the Committee that NCEM had purchased E-Plan through October 2014 and then would likely be switching to another product by the name of Tier II Manager.

A total of 83 facilities had filed Tier II reports by the March 1st deadline in Randolph County for the 2013 reporting year.

HMEP Grant

Chairman Byrd updated the Committee that we had again applied for the HMEP grant in an attempt to host an exercise. There was \$50,000 available in central NC with a maximum of \$10,000 grant per LEPC. A total of 11 LEPC's in central NC applied for the grant with Anson, Durham, Franklin, Halifax, and Surry LEPC's receiving the award. Ricky Tuttle informed the Committee that he felt this year had the most participation throughout the central branch.

By-Laws Change

Chairman Byrd reminded the Committee that at the January meeting there was a proposed By-Law change to allow a general membership to the Committee in addition to the voting membership. Per the current By-Laws, any change had to be circulated to the Committee at least 30 days prior to any action being taken. Committee members looked over the proposed changes and the proposed membership application.

Motion: Annette Jordan made a motion to accept the changes to the By-Laws as proposed with a second from Danny Mull. Motion carried unanimously.
