### LEPC Membership

The Randolph County LEPC is made up of two types of memberships:

**LEPC General Member** – Membership of the LEPC is open to public safety personnel, businesses, industry, and citizens. The only requirements of an active member is submitting a membership application and attending at least one LEPC meeting per calendar year. An LEPC member may volunteer to serve in other capacities, such as LEPC subcommittees. Membership will be considered active for 12 months from the last attended regularly scheduled LEPC meeting.

**LEPC Voting Member** – Voting membership includes 13 members designated by the Randolph County Board of Commissioners and will have voting privileges on LEPC business. Voting Members serve two year terms.
