#### Tier II Grant

Jared Byrd informed the committee that NCEM had released the Tier II grant, raised from Tier II fees that facilities pay. Randolph County had received \$1,000 to be used for LEPC activities. Jared Byrd asked the committee to forward ideas on what this money could be used for to him.

#### **Emergency Management Incidents**

Jared Byrd briefed the Committee on Hazardous Material incidents that Emergency Management has responded to since the last meeting.

- a. 05/01/2017 – Report of Illegal Dumping, Surrent Dr, Archdale
- b. 05/12/2017 – Vehicle accident into a creek. Old Lexington Rd, Asheboro
- c. 05/19/2017 – Vehicle accident releasing diesel fuel. NC Hwy 22 N, Franklinville.
- d. 06/15/2017 – Oil Spill. Railroad tracks near Old 421 Rd, Staley.

#### **Round Table Discussion**

David Leonard (NC Emergency Management) encouraged using the \$1,000 to promote the LEPC. He also gave examples of what other LEPC's had completed with their funds in previous years. He also mentioned that NCEM, EPA, and water and utilities groups would begin meeting to discuss issues dealt with when water utilities are down.

Cathryn Davis (Randolph County Risk Manager) mentioned the Randolph County Business Continuity Plan that was ongoing. Promoted the Hands-Only CPR program for businesses.

Jared Byrd discussed ongoing road naming projects for the 64 construction. He also mentioned upcoming federal legislation that would require more preparedness initiatives and exercise participation for healthcare agencies that receive federal dollars.

Donovan Davis mentioned the Dixie Drive revitalization project occurring with the 64 Bypass project.

Dana Wright said a new medical counter-measures plan replaces the SNS plan. A presentation will be made to the LEPC once completed.

Mandy Shields with the American Red Cross said they are working to open a center in Asheboro again. It will be off Cox St in Asheboro.

Hearing no further comments, *Motion* by Skip Richey to adjourn, *second* by Jared Byrd. Meeting adorned.
